

Fleas, Ticks & Heartworms... What Product Is Right For My Pet?

With so many different products available, how do you decide what product is right for you and your pet? We've compiled the following information in hopes of making your decisions easier.

Advantage

- Only kills fleas.
- Lasts one month.
- Applied topically, does not absorb internally.
- Use in dogs at least 7 weeks old and cats at least 8 weeks of age.



advantage

Frontline

- Kills fleas and ticks (4 kinds).
- Lasts one month.
- Applied topically, does not absorb internally.
- Safe for use in dogs and cats 8 weeks of age and older.



Revolution

- Kills fleas and ticks (only 1 kind).
- Also prevents heartworms.
- Lasts one month.
- Treats ear mites.
- Treats sarcoptic mange
- In cats, Revolution also treats roundworms and hookworms.
- Applied topically, but is absorbed and works internally.
- Use in dogs at least 6 weeks of age and cats at least 8 weeks of age.



Comfortis

- For dogs only.
- Kills fleas.
- Given orally.
- Lasts one month.
- Use in dogs older than 14 weeks.



Heartgard Plus

- Prevents heartworms.
- Also treats roundworms and hookworms.
- Given orally.
- Lasts one month.
- Safe in dogs 6 weeks of age and older.
- Use with caution in collies and collie crosses.



Interceptor

- Prevents heartworms.
- Also treats roundworms, whipworms and hookworms.
- Given orally.
- Lasts one month.
- Safe in dogs 4 weeks of age and older and at least 2 pounds of weight.
